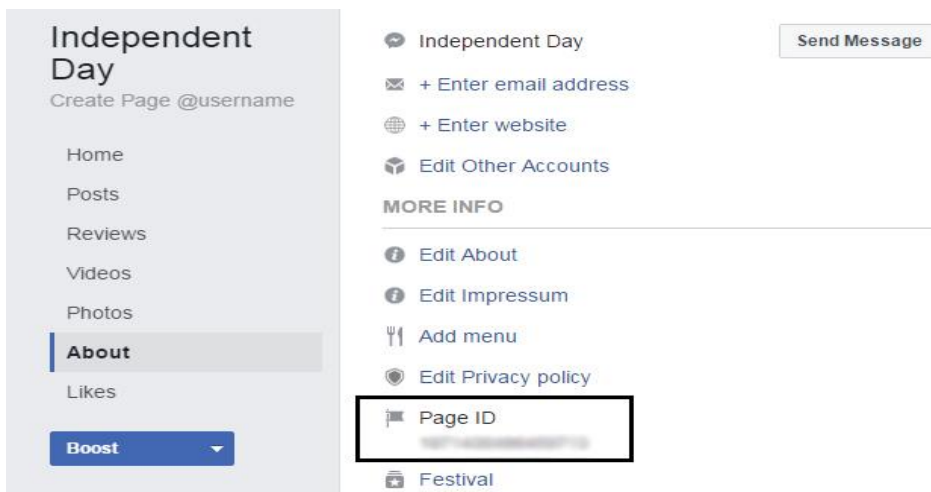
- 5) After Stared page then you can see your created page on Manage Page Tab. Click on this tab

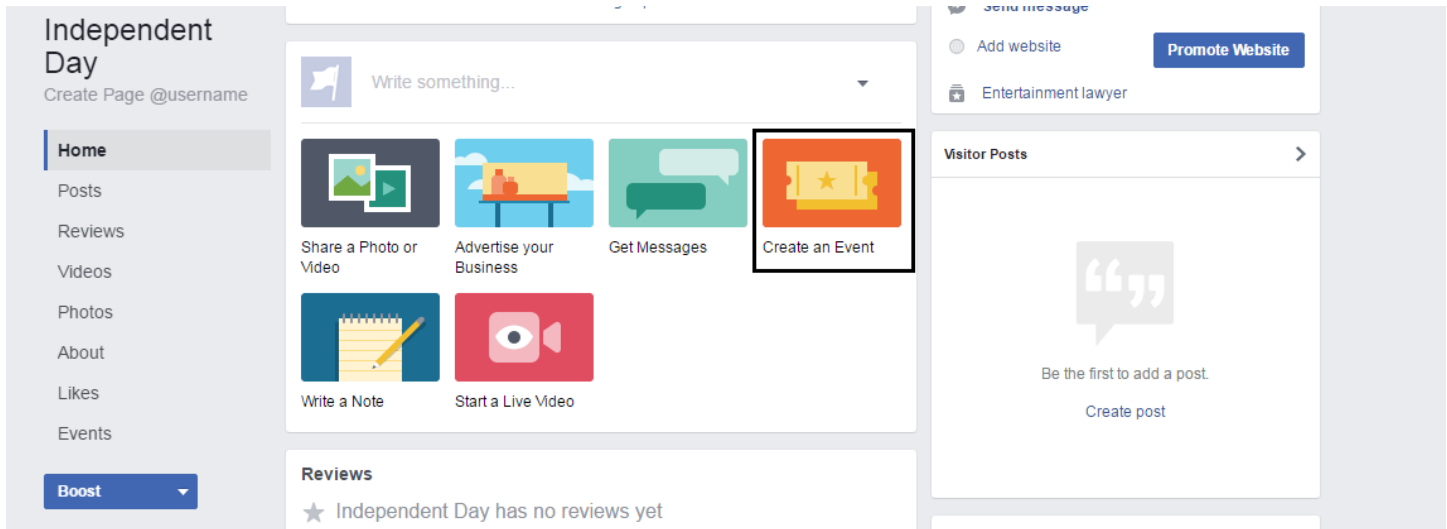

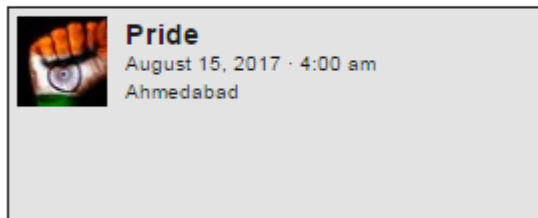
- Copy this key and enter in to your wordpress sidebar widget > Facebook Event > Access Token tab and save it.
